A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to vest certain Land in the Bluff Harbour Board as an Endowment for the Bluff Harbour. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is “The Bluff Harbour Foreshore Endowment Act, 1879.” Short Title.

2. The lands of the Crown in the Provincial District of Otago, described in the Schedule hereto, are hereby set aside as an endowment for the Corporation of the Bluff Harbour Board as constituted by “The Bluff Harbour Board Act, 1876,” for the use and benefit of the Bluff Harbour. Endowment.

SCHEDULE.

Schedule.

ALL that piece of land containing by estimation 8,500 acres, more or less, lying between low-water mark and high-water mark, constituting the foreshore of Bluff Harbour and Awarua Bay, and extending from starting point along the western, northern, and eastern margins of Bluff Harbour; thereafter along the northern, eastern, and southern margins of Awarua Bay; thence again along the eastern margin of Bluff Harbour and the entrance thereto to Teawaewae Point, the point of termination, including the Railway Pier Reserve, Campbelltown.
