A BILL INTITULED

An Act to make lawful the intended marriage between Brian Edward Blomfield and Janine Shirley Kohi

WHEREAS Brian Edward Blomfield of Invercargill, smelter
5 employee and Janine Shirley Kohi of Invercargill, widow are
desirous of marrying: And whereas the said Brian Edward
Blomfield is the said Janine Shirley Kohi's mother's brother:
And whereas the said Janine Shirley Kohi is the said Brian
Edward Blomfield's sister's daughter: And whereas the
10 intended marriage is within the degrees of prohibition con-
tained in the Second Schedule to the Marriage Act 1955:
And whereas by reason of a motor accident on the 4th day
of January, 1971 and the subsequent sub-total hysterectomy
the said Janine Shirley Kohi is unable to bear children:
15 And whereas no legal grounds exist for removing the
prohibition:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New
Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Blomfield-Kohi Marriage Act 1973.

2. Removal of prohibition—It is hereby declared that the degrees of prohibition contained in the Second Schedule to the Marriage Act 1955 are hereby removed in so far as they affect the intended marriage between Brian Edward Blomfield and Janine Shirley Kohi, in the special circumstances peculiar to this case. 5

3. Private Act—This Act is hereby declared to be a private Act. 10
