**A BILL INTITULED**

An Act to amend "The Bills of Exchange Act, 1883."

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand, in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Bills of Exchange Act 1883 Amendment Act, 1884." Short Title.

2. From and after the passing of this Act the ninety-sixth section of the said "Bills of Exchange Act, 1883," shall be and is hereby repealed, excepting in so far as the same applies to the North Island of the Colony of New Zealand. Section ninety-six repealed, excepting as to North Island.
