A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Companies Act, 1882."

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Companies Act 1882 Amendment Act, 1887." Short Title.

2. Section two of "The Companies Act, 1882," is hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof it is hereby enacted as follows: This Act shall apply to persons associated together for the purpose of banking within the colony, and it shall also apply to persons associated or hereafter to be associated together for carrying on banking at any place out of the colony. Section two of "The Companies Act, 1882," amended.
