Any company formed and having its head office in New Company may be Zealand for the purpose of carrying on the business of life assurcapital £10,000. ance, by issuing policies of assurance upon human life, may be 10 registered under "The Companies Act, 1882," as a Company with limited liability, but no such company shall commence to do business in New Zealand unless and until it has a paid-up capital of at least £10,000.
