A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Companies Act, 1882."

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

5 1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Companies Act 1882 Amendment Act, 1899." Short Title.

10 2. Any company formed and having its head office in New Zealand for the purpose of carrying on the business of life assurance, by issuing policies of assurance upon human life, may be registered under "The Companies Act, 1882," as a Company with limited liability, but no such company shall commence to do business in New Zealand unless and until it has a paid-up capital of at least £10,000. Company may be registered. Paid up capital £10,000.
