A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Counties Act, 1886.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Counties Act 1886 Amendment Act, 1908.

Short Title.

2. Notwithstanding anything in section eighty-two of the Counties Act, 1886, the Council of the Bruce County shall consist of not less than six nor more than eleven members.
