AN ACT to amend "The Counties Act, 1886."

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in
Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as fol-

5 lows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Counties Act Amend-
ment Act, 1899."

Short Title.

2. In every case where, by any Act specified in the Schedule
hereto, a county has been constituted, it is hereby declared that on
10 the date of the commencement of such Act every road district then
existing within the boundaries of such county shall be deemed to
have been abolished and to have been merged in the county, and the
provisions of section fifty-seven of "The Counties Act, 1886," shall
be deemed to have applied.
