- 2. Section thirty-seven of the Coal-mines Act, 1905, is hereby Section 37 of Coal-mines Act, 1905, amended. amended by repealing all the words from the commencement of that 10 section down to and inclusive of the words "Amendment Act, 1903." New clause.
- 3. Section sixty-one of the Coal-mines Act, 1905, is hereby Section 61 of amended by the addition of the following words after the word "counsel" in line ten: "and also any person, being a miner working in the mining district, duly authorised in writing by the miners' union of the district in which the accident occurred."
