A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Coal-mines Act, 1905.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Coal-mines Act Amendment Act, 1907.

Short Title.

2. Section thirty-seven of the Coal-mines Act, 1905, is hereby amended by repealing all the words from the commencement of that section down to and inclusive of the words "Amendment Act, 1903."

Section 37 of Coal-mines Act, 1905, amended.

3. Section sixty-one of the Coal-mines Act, 1905, is hereby amended by the addition of the following words after the word "counsel" in line ten: "and also any person, being a miner working in the mining district, duly authorised in writing by the miners' union of the district in which the accident occurred."

Section 61 of Coal-mines Act, 1905, amended.
