A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Counties Act, ~~1886~~ 1908.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Counties ~~Act—1886~~ Amendment Act, 1908.

Short Title.

2. Notwithstanding anything in section ~~eighty-two~~ *fifty-nine* of the Counties Act, ~~1886~~ 1908, the Council of the Bruce County shall consist of not less than six nor more than eleven members. Governor may from time to time, on the resolution of the Council of any county, by Order in Council gazetted, increase the number of members of the Council of such county to any number not exceeding twelve.
