AN ACT to extend the Duration of the Companies Amendment Act, 1922. Title.

5 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand
in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Companies Amendment Act, 1923. Short Title.

10 2. (1.) The Companies Amendment Act, 1922, shall continue in
force until the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and
twenty-four, and no longer. Extension of

(2.) Section four of the Companies Amendment Act, 1922, is
hereby repealed. Consequential
repeal.
