A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to constitute the Aorere Riding of the County of Collingwood a County. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Collingwood County Act, 1903." Short Title.

2. This Act shall come into force on the first day of April, one thousand nine hundred and four. Date of Act coming into operation.

3. A county is hereby constituted, comprising the Aorere Riding of the County of Collingwood, particularly described in the Schedule hereto; and the boundaries of the County of Collingwood are hereby altered accordingly. Constitution of county.

4. The now existing County of Collingwood shall be called the County of Takaka, and the county hereby constituted shall be called the County of Collingwood. Collingwood Road District abolished.

5. The Collingwood Road District is hereby abolished, and shall be deemed to be merged in the County of Collingwood constituted by this Act. Name of new county, and change of name of existing County of Collingwood.

SCHEDULE.

Schedule.

ALL that area in the Nelson Land District bounded towards the north by the ocean and Golden Bay to the mouth of the River Pariwhaka-aho in Section 79; thence towards the east by a line drawn to the summit of Slate River Peak, and along the watershed to the summit of Mount Snowdon; towards the south by Buller County; and towards the west by the ocean.
