A BILL INTITULED

**An Act to amend the Christchurch District Drainage Act
1951**

5 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand
in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same,
as follows:

1. **Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the Christchurch
District Drainage Amendment Act 1970, and shall be read
10 together with and deemed part of the Christchurch District
Drainage Act 1951 (hereinafter referred to as the principal
Act).

2. **Allowance to Chairman**—(1) Section 19A of the princi-
pal Act (as inserted by section 2 of the Christchurch District
15 Drainage Amendment Act 1960) is hereby amended by
omitting from subsection (1) the words “four hundred
pounds”, and substituting the words “fifteen hundred dollars”.

New

20 (2) Notwithstanding anything in section 19A of the princi-
pal Act (as amended by subsection (1) of this section), the
allowance of the Chairman of the Board who is in office at
the date of the passing of this Act may, by resolution of the
Board passed within 6 months after that date, be increased
once during his term of office.
