A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Civil List Act 1863 Amendment Act, 1873." Title.

WHEREAS it is expedient that the amount now payable under "The Civil List Act 1863 Amendment Act, 1873" (hereinafter called "the said Act"), for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the services mentioned in the Second Schedule of the said Act, should be reduced as and in manner hereinafter provided: Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Civil List Act, 1877." Short Title.

2. Instead of the sum of ten thousand and fifty pounds which, by the third section of the said Act, is appropriated for the purposes mentioned in the Second Schedule thereto, there shall be payable to Her Majesty for and during the year ending the thirtieth day of June next, and every year thereafter, out of the Consolidated Fund, the sum of seven thousand eight hundred pounds, and such sum shall be applied towards defraying the expenses of the services mentioned in the Schedule hereto. Appropriation for salaries of Ministers.

3. The third section of the said Act, and the Second Schedule thereto, are hereby repealed, and the said Act and this Act shall together be read as one Act. Repeal of third section and Second Schedule.

THE annual salary of a member of the Executive Council, being the Prime Minister, holding any one or more of the offices mentioned in the Third Schedule to the said Act	£
