2. How holders of deferred-payment license or lease may obtain Crown grant.

A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to remedy certain Wrongs that have arisen from the Operation of "The Crown Lands Sales Act, 1877." Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Crown Lands Sales Act 1877 Remedies Act, 1882." Short Title.

2. Any holder of a deferred-payment license or lease who shall, during the period in which "The Crown Land Sales Act, 1877," was in operation, have selected an allotment or section from or out of a block of land which at the time of or previous to the passing of the said Act was or had been open for selection, shall at any time after the passing of this Act be entitled to receive a Crown grant for the land included in his license or lease, on paying the difference between the sum of the rents paid by him and a sum calculated for the area of his allotment or section at the rate of the price per acre at which land in such block was or had been open for selection previous to the passing of "The Crown Lands Sales Act, 1877," aforesaid. How holders of deferred-payment license or lease may obtain Crown grant.
