A BILL INTITULED

AN Act to extend the operation of "The Canterbury Roads Ordinance Amendment Act, 1877," in certain cases. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Canterbury Roads Ordinance Amendment Act Extension Act, 1880." Short Title.

5 2. The provisions of "The Canterbury Roads Ordinance Amendment Act, 1877," shall extend to all cases in which a petition is presented under the seventh section of "The Canterbury Roads Ordinance, 1872," for annexing any part of a district to an adjoining or contiguous district. Extension of "The Canterbury Roads Ordinance Amendment Act, 1877," to cases where a petition is presented for annexation to a contiguous district.
