A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to provide a Rota of Attendance for Chemists.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

5 1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Chemists' Rota of Attendance Act, 1901." Short Title.

10 2. The Governor in Council, notwithstanding anything contained in "The Shops and Shop-assistants Act, 1901," may from time to time make and prescribe regulations, to be published in the *Gazette*, providing a rota of attendance for chemists in any city or borough in New Zealand. Governor to make regulations.

3. It shall be the duty of any chemist whose name appears on such rota to have some qualified chemist in attendance on his premises at the hours and on the days set forth in such regulations. Qualified chemist to be in attendance.

15 4. Any chemist failing to comply with the duty imposed upon him by such regulations shall be guilty of an offence, and be liable on conviction to a fine of not less than *one* pound nor more than *twenty* pounds. Penalty.
