## Clemow Scrip.

### A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to authorize the issue of Land Scrip, exercisable in the Province of Taranaki, to Robert Clemow. Title.

WHEREAS Robert Clemow lately emigrated with his family from England to the Province of Taranaki, and also provided free passages from England of certain farm labourers and servants: And whereas the expenses incurred by the said Robert Clemow in the emigration of himself and family, and of such of the farm labourers and servants as have remained in the said Province, amount to the sum of five hundred pounds: And whereas it is expedient that the Superintendent of the said Province should be empowered to issue to the said Robert Clemow scrip in repayment of the cost of such immigration: Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Clemow Scrip Act, 1873." Short Title.

2. It shall be lawful for the Superintendent of the said Province to issue to the said Robert Clemow scrip to the amount of three hundred pounds, which shall be available in the purchase of land in any part of the Province of Taranaki, subject to the land regulations of the said Province. Superintendent empowered to scrip.
