1. This Act may be cited as the Christchurch Tramway District Short Title. Act 1906 Amendment Act, 1910.

2. (1.) Section three of the principal Act Christchurch Tramway

20 District Act, 1906, is hereby repealed.

3. (2.) The Governor from time to time, and upon the petition of the majority of the ratepayers of any borough or portion of a borough, or of any road district or portion of a road district, or of any ward or portion of a ward of any borough or road district, shall by Order in 25 Council direct that such borough or road district, or ward, or portion of a borough, or road district, or ward, as the case may be, shall thenceforth be incorporated with and form a portion of the Christchurch Tramway District; and upon such Order being gazetted, any borough, or road district, or ward, or portion of a borough, or road district, or ward, 30 so directed to be incorporated shall thenceforth be and be deemed to-be incorporated with and form a portion of the said district: and the Board, in relation to tramways within any borough or road

Section-three-of This Act shall have a retroactive force and effect, and any direction by the Governor which has been made prior to the passing of this Act incorporating or purporting to incorporate any portion of any borough, or road district, or ward, with the Christchurch Tramway District shall be deemed to be valid, and shall 10 possess the same force and effect as if section-three-of this Act had been originally enacted in lieu of the said section three of the principal-Act.
