A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to legalise Marriage with the Brother of a Deceased Husband. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Deceased Husband's Brother Marriage Act, 1893." Short Title.

2. Marriages are permissible, may be solemnised, and are legal between a woman and her deceased husband's brother. Marriages with deceased husband's brother permissible and legal.
