BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as

2. The power conferred upon the Judges of the Supreme Court Power of Judges to appropriate fees to examiners of candidates for admission as Practitioners Act, barristers and solicitors by "The Law Practitioners Act Amendment 1877," to continue Act, 1877," shall continue to subsist when a District Law Society upon formation of District Law 10 shall be established under "The District Law Societies Act, 1878."

3.
