A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Destitute Persons Act, 1894.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand
in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
5 follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Destitute Persons Act
Amendment Act, 1908. Short Title.

2. Section eight of the Destitute Persons Act, 1894, is
hereby amended by adding thereto the following clause:— Section 8 of the
Destitute Persons
Act, 1894, amended.

10 “(3.) Provided that a Magistrate shall not make an order for
payment against any grandfather, grandmother, or grandchild of any
destitute person unless he shall first be satisfied that proper steps and
proceedings have been taken against the other near relatives, as
15 defined by this Act, of such destitute person, and that such other near
relatives are not able to maintain or contribute to the maintenance
of such destitute person.”
