A BILL INTITULED

An Act for the Constitution of Egmont County.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as 5 follows:-

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Egmont County Act, Short Title. 1893."

2. The Egmont County is hereby constituted, and shall com- Constitution of prise all those portions of the Hawera and Taranaki Counties which 10 are included in the boundaries particularly described in the Schedule hereto.

3. So much of the Waimate Road District, hitherto within the Constitution of Hawera County, as is now by this Act included in the Egmont road district. County aforesaid is hereby constituted a new road district within 15 the Egmont County aforesaid; and all provisions of "The Road

Boards Act, 1882," and of every other Act, shall apply in respect of the foregoing new road district constituted under this section, as if it had been duly constituted by the Hawera County Council, on petition under section four of "The Road Boards Act, 1882." 20

4. So much of the former Waimate Road District as does not lie Constitution of within the Egmont County shall be deemed to be a road district whose road district. boundaries have been altered by the formation of new districts under section four of "The Road Boards Act, 1882," to which the provisions of section thirteen of the last-named Act shall be applicable,

25 with this exception only: That it shall be optional with the Hawera County Council to dissolve the Board of such district, and not imperative, as provided in the said section thirteen.

SCHEDULE.
