A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Employment of Females and Others Act, 1881."

WHEREAS it is desirable to amend "The Employment of Females Preamble. 5 and Others Act, 1881," hereinafter called "the said Act":

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :--

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Employment of Females short Title. 10 and Others Act 1881 Amendment Act, 1884."

2. Section two of the said Act is hereby amended as follows: Interpretation. "Child": means a boy or girl between the ages of twelve and fourteen years.

Clause erased.

3. Section five of the said Act is hereby amended as follows: 15 The words "young person" are added after the word "female" and before the word "or" in the first line of the said section.

4. 3. Section eleven of the said Act is hereby amended as follows : Breaches of Act. The words "during working hours" at the end of the said section 20 are hereby struck out.
