## A BILL INTITULED

An Act to declare the Validity of the Elections of Title. certain Members of the House of Representatives.

WHEREAS doubts have been raised as to whether the several Preamble. persons mentioned in the Schedule to this Act were duly elected at the last general election for the electoral districts set opposite their names respectively, and it is expedient that such doubts should be removed:

BE IT THEREFORE DECLARED AND ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Elections Validation Act, Short Title. 10 1879."

2. The several persons whose names are set forth in the Schedule Names of persons to this Act were duly elected for the several electoral districts set set forth in Schedule deemed duly elected opposite their names respectively, and they have not been and are not to the House of disqualified from sitting and voting in the House of Representatives Representatives. 15 accordingly.

3. Every of the said persons shall be and is hereby indemnified, Indemnity to such freed, and discharged from and against all penalties, forfeitures, incapa- persons. cities, and disabilities whatsoever (if any), incurred or to be incurred by him by reason or in consequence of his having heretofore sat or 20 voted, or his hereafter sitting and voting, as a member of the House of Representatives.

4. This Act shall not apply to or affect any disqualification, Application of Act penalty, forfeiture, incapacity, or disability which may arise or be incurred in consequence of any act, matter, or thing done, committed, 25 or suffered, or which may exist after the passing of this Act.

New Clause.

5. It shall not be lawful for any defendant in any action, suit, costs of action bill of indictment, or information to avail himself of the provisions of pending to be paid this Act until he shall have tendered the payment of costs previously nifed. 30 fincurred in such action, suit, bill of indictment, or information.
