

FISHERIES AMENDMENT BILL

EXPLANATORY NOTE

THIS Bill amends the Fisheries Act 1908 and the Fisheries Amendment Act 1963.

Clause 2: Section 83 (2A) of the 1908 Act is being amended by repealing the proviso to paragraph (a) which provides that the depositing of debris from mining claims is deemed not to be pollution.

Clause 3 repeals subsection (8) of section 10A of the 1963 Act, which prevents oyster fishermen from carrying on crayfishing in the close season for oysters.

A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend the Fisheries Act 1908

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same,
5 as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Fisheries Amendment Act 1970, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fisheries Act 1908* (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

10 **2. Regulations relating to the pollution of rivers, etc.**—Section 83 of the principal Act (as amended by section 3 of the Fisheries Amendment Act 1969) is hereby amended by repealing the proviso to paragraph (a) of subsection (2A).

15 **3. Boat-fishing permits for oyster dredging in Foveaux Strait**—Section 10A of the Fisheries Amendment Act 1963 (as inserted by section 8 of the Fisheries Amendment Act (No. 2) 1969) is hereby amended by repealing subsection (8).
