2. Trout-fishing season in Rotorua County extended.

A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Fisheries Conservation Act Amendment Act, 1903. Title.

5 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Fisheries Conservation Act Amendment Act, 1907. Short Title.

10 2. Notwithstanding anything in section two of the Fisheries Conservation Act Amendment Act, 1903, the Governor may in any year by notification in the *Gazette* extend the open season for trout-fishing in the Acclimatisation District of Rotorua, or any part thereof, to the thirty-first day of May, inclusive, in that year. Trout-fishing season in Rotorua County extended.
