A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to abolish the Import Duty on Flour.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Flour Duty Abolition Act, 1907. Short Title.

2. On and after the coming into operation of this Act the duty levied upon flour imported into New Zealand under the Customs Duties Consolidation Act, 1882, and the several Acts incorporated therewith is hereby abolished, and from and after that date shall wholly cease to be levied and collected. Flour duty abolished.
