A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Forest Trees Planting Encouragement Act, 1871," and "The Forest Trees Planting Encouragement Act Amendment Act, 1872."

WHEREAS it is desirable that the encouragement offered under "The Forest Trees Planting Encouragement Act, 1871," and "The Forest Trees Planting Encouragement Act Amendment Act, 1872," should be given to local governing bodies:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Forest Trees Planting Encouragement Acts Amendment Act, 1879."
2. The term "local governing body" shall include any County Council, Road Board, Highway Board, or Borough Council.
3. The term "person," in section three of "The Forest Trees Planting Encouragement Act, 1871," shall include the Chairman of a local governing body.
4. Any local governing body may avail itself of the provisions of "The Forest Trees Planting Encouragement Act, 1871," and "The Forest Trees Planting Encouragement Act Amendment Act, 1872," and shall be entitled to receive all the benefits therein provided, as in the case of a person.
