A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Gaming Act, 1908.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Gaming Amendment and Bookmakers Abolition Act, 1910, and shall form part of and be read together with the Gaming Act, 1908. Short Title.

2. Section thirty-four of the Gaming Act, 1908, is hereby repealed, and on the passing of this Act all licenses in force thereunder shall lapse and be of no effect. Repeal.

3. The Gaming Act, 1908, is hereby further amended in the manner and to the extent indicated in the Schedule hereto. Amendments of Gaming Act.

AMENDMENTS OF GAMING ACT.

No. of Section amended.	Nature of Amendment.
Section 24 (1)	By omitting the words "any horse-race or to."
" 24 (4)	By omitting the words "or a racecourse on which a race-meeting is being held."
" 26 (4)	By inserting, after the words "sports means," the words "horse-races, pony-races," and after the words "football matches" the words "shooting matches or competitions."
