A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend "The Gaming and Lotteries Act, 1881." Title. WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Gaming and Lotteries Preamble. Act, 1881: (hereinafter referred to as "the said Act").

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :-

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Gaming and Lotteries short Title. Act 1881 Amendment Act, 1884."
