## A BILL INTITULED

An Act to abolish Duties on Gold, and for other Purposes.

WHEREAS it is expedient that the duties upon gold should be Preamble. reduced and ultimately abolished:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same,

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Gold Duties Abolition Short Title. Act, 1879."

2. In this Act the term "the said Act" means "The Gold Duties How to be read. Act, 1872."

3. In lieu of the duties authorized by the said Act to be levied Duties to be 10 and collected, there shall be levied, collected, and paid to Her Majesty, collected. her heirs and successors, at the Customs, previous to exportation from New Zealand, the following duties upon gold, that is to say,-

Upon every ounce troy weight of gold of the fineness of twenty 15 carats and upwards, and so in proportion for any less quantity than

> On and after the first day of January, one thou-) One shilling sand eight hundred and eighty ... \ and sixpence.

On and after the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and eighty one One shilling.

On and after the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-two Sixpence.

And so in proportion upon every ounce or part of an ounce of gold of a less degree of fineness than twenty carats.

4. On and after the thirty-first day of December, one thousand When duties to eight hundred and eighty-four, duties on gold shall altogether cease to cease. be levied and collected.

5. The provisions contained in the sections of "The Gold Duties Sections 4 to 12 of Act, 1870," numbered from four to twelve, both inclusive, shall be "Gold Duties Act, 1870," incorporated. 30 deemed to be incorporated in this Act and read as part hereof.

6. "The Gold Duties Act, 1872," shall be and be deemed to be Repeal of "Gold repealed upon the coming into operation of the provisions of this Act. Duties Act, 1872."

7. Subsection two of section thirty-seven of "The Rating Act, Repeal of part of "Rating Act, 1876." 1876," shall be and the same is hereby repealed.
