Preamble. 1. Short Title. 2. £150,000 may be borrowed for Greymouth Harbour.

A BILL INTITULED

An Act to declare the Amount authorized to be Borrowed under Title. "The Greymouth Harbour Board Act, 1884," passed in this present Session of the General Assembly.

5 WHEREAS a clerical error has occurred in section eight of "The Preamble. Greymouth Harbour Board Act, 1884" (herein referred to as "the said Act "), whereby the sum of one hundred thousand pounds only is authorized to be borrowed under the said Act in lieu of the sum of one hundred and fifty thousand pounds, as it should have been: For 10 rectification of the said error:

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as fol-

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Greymouth Harbour Short Title. 15 Board Act (No. 2) 1884," and it shall be read together with, and be deemed to be incorporated with, the said Act.

2. Section eight of the said Act, and all other provisions of the £150,000 may be said Act, shall be read and construed as if the words "one hundred borrowed for Greymouth Harbour. and fifty thousand pounds" had been originally enacted in section 20 eight aforesaid, in the place of the words "one hundred thousand

pounds" where they occur in the said section.
