A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Greymouth Harbour Board Loans Consolidation Act, 1910. Title.

5 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Greymouth Harbour Board Loans Consolidation Amendment Act, 1910, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Greymouth Harbour Board Loans Consolidation Act, 1910 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act). Short Title.

2. The preamble in the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting the following words in the preamble after the words "fifty thousand pounds," in line 15 of the preamble:— Preamble of principal Act amended.

15 "And whereas by the Greymouth Harbour Board Loan Act, 1907, the Board was authorized to borrow on the security of its endowments, and subject to the conditions and for the purposes set out in the Act now in recital, any sum not exceeding fifty thousand pounds:"
