A BILL INTITULED

An Act to further amend "The Gisborne High School Act, 1885." Title. BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as fol-5 lows:---

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Gisborne High School Short Title. Act 1885 Further Amendment Act, 1893."

2. "The Gisborne High School Act, 1885" and "The Gis-Gisborne High borne High School Act 1885 Amendment Act, 1887," are to be read incorporated. 10 herewith.

3. "The Board" may out of revenue set apart a sum in any one Power to set aside year, not exceeding the sum of one hundred and fifty pounds, for the grant of scholarships to children who have been educated at any £150 in any one Government school in the County of Cook or Borough of Gisborne, year for scholar-15 which county and borough shall constitute "the special district" for the purposes and within the meaning of this Act.

4. Scholarships granted by the Board shall be granted, Scholarships to be subject to such regulations and conditions as it may approve, and granted subject to which are assented to by the Governor.
