A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to extend to Town Boards the Provisions of "The Title. Government Loans to Local Bodies Act Amendment Act, 1898," relating to Loans for the Purposes of Irrigation, Water-

supply, and Water-conservation. $\mathbf{5}$

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :-

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Government Loans to Short Title.

10 Local Bodies Acts Amendment Act, 1899." 2. For all the purposes of "The Government Loans to Local Town Board Bodies Act Amendment Act, 1898," a Town Board shall be deemed a local authority. to be a local authority within the meaning of section two of that Act, and the provisions of that Act shall be construed accordingly.
