A BILL INTITULED

An Act to declare that certain Private Streets and Private Ways Title. in the Borough of Gore are Streets.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand 5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :---

1. This Act may be cited as the Gore Streets Act, 1907.

2. The private streets and private ways mentioned in the Streets declared Schedule hereto and situate in the Borough of Gore are hereby public streets. 10 declared to be streets within the meaning of the Municipal Corporations Act, 1900.

3. The Council of the Borough of Gore may exercise over the Power of Council said streets and ways all the rights conferred upon Municipal Cor- over such streets. porations under the Municipal Corporations Act, 1900, or any other

15 Act or Acts for the time being in force giving Municipal Corporations power over streets.

New clauses.

3A. Notwithstanding anything in the Municipal Corporations New buildings Act, 1900, or its amendments, no new building shall, after the on private ways. 20 passing of this Act, be erected, used, or occupied as a dwellinghouse or as ancillary to a dwellinghouse within the Borough of Gore on land fronting any private way, unless every part of such building is distant at least thirty-three feet from the centre line (as defined by

the Council) of such private way, or at least thirty-three feet from 25 the end of any private way having only one outlet, or unless such land abuts on a street or a private street or another private way not less than sixty-six feet wide :

Provided that this section shall not apply to any building for which a permit has, before the passing of this Act, been granted by 30 the Council.

Penalty for unlawful erection of buildings.

Power of Council over part of the Mataura River bed. **3**B. If any person erects any building contrary to the provisions of this Act, such person is liable to a penalty not exceeding *two* pounds for every day during which such breach continues.

4. Notwithstanding anything in any Act, the said Council shall have and may exercise over such part of the bed of the Mataura River as lies within the boundary of the Borough of Gore, all the powers conferred upon local authorities in respect of streets by the Municipal Corporations Act, 1900, and the Public Works Act, 1905.
