A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to prohibit the Erection of Hoardings outside Title.
Urban Areas

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New
5 Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Hoardings Act, Short Title.
1948.

2. (1) Subject to the provisions of this section, no Prohibiting
10 person shall erect or maintain or cause or permit to be hoardings
erected or maintained or to remain on any land outside outside
a borough or town district any hoarding displaying urban areas.
any advertisement, notice, or sign.

(2) This section shall not be construed to prohibit
15 the erection or maintenance of a hoarding displaying
only—

(a) A notice or sign the display of which is
required or authorized by any Act or
regulations:

20 (b) An advertisement, notice, or sign relating only
to a business, trade, or occupation carried on
on the land on which the hoarding is erected.

(3) Any hoarding existing on the passing of this Act (and erected not later than the *first* day of *July*, nineteen hundred and forty-eight) may be maintained in the position and condition in which it was on the passing of this Act for any period expiring not later than two years after the passing of this Act. 5

(4) Every person who acts in contravention of the provisions of this section commits an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding *twenty-five* pounds, and if the offence is a continuing one, to a further fine not exceeding *one* pound for every day during which the offence continues. 10
