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### A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to sever the Heathcote Road District from the Selwyn County, and to constitute in Substitution for the said District a County to be called the Heathcote County. Title.

5 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Heathcote County Act, 1910. Short Title.

10 2. The Heathcote County is hereby constituted, and shall comprise all that area the boundaries whereof are particularly described in the *First* Schedule hereto, being that portion of the Selwyn County known as the Heathcote Road District. Heathcote County constituted.

15 3. The said Heathcote Road District is hereby abolished, and shall be deemed to be merged in the said Heathcote County; and the provisions of section thirty-six of the Counties Act, 1908, shall apply accordingly. Heathcote Road District abolished.

4. The boundaries of the said Selwyn County are hereby altered as described in the *Second* Schedule hereto. Boundaries of Selwyn County.

20 5. From and after the coming into operation of this Act no local body or authority other than the Council of the Heathcote County shall, within the limits of the said county, exercise any jurisdiction or authority whatsoever over any roads or over or in relation to any matter or thing whatsoever in respect of which jurisdiction is conferred upon County Councils under any Act: Jurisdiction of Heathcote County Council.

25 Provided that nothing herein shall affect the power of the Governor to proclaim any portion of the said county a borough, town, or other district.

## SCHEDULES.

## FIRST SCHEDULE.

## BOUNDARIES OF HEATHCOTE COUNTY.

ALL that area in the Canterbury Land District bounded towards the north generally by the Waimairi County from the City of Christchurch to the Borough of New Brighton; thence towards the east generally by the Borough of New Brighton to the estuary of the Heathcote and Avon Rivers; thence towards the south-east by the said estuary to the north-eastern boundary of the Borough of Woolston; and thence towards the south-west generally by the Borough of Woolston and the City of Christchurch to the place of commencement.

Also all that area in the Canterbury Land District bounded towards the east by the western boundary of the Borough of Sumner from the southern side of the estuary of the Heathcote and Avon Rivers to the northern boundary of the Borough of Lyttelton; towards the south by the northern boundary of the said Borough of Lyttelton to the westernmost corner thereof, and the summit of the Port Hills to the middle of Dyer's Pass Road; towards the west by a line along the middle of that road and Colombo Road South to the Heathcote River; towards the north-west generally by that river from Colombo Road South to the southern end of Wilson's Road, and by that road to the south-western side of the Christchurch and Lyttelton Railway Reserve; towards the north-east by the south-western side of the said reserve from Wilson's Road to Hillsborough Road; again by the western side of that road northerly to the River Heathcote, and by the right bank of that river and the southern side of the estuary of the Heathcote and Avon Rivers, to the place of commencement.

## SECOND SCHEDULE.

## BOUNDARIES OF SELWYN COUNTY.

ALL that area in the Canterbury Land District bounded towards the north, east, and north-east by the Tawera County; towards the north-west by the County of Westland; towards the south-west by the Ashburton County; and towards the east and south-east by the proposed Hororata County.

Also all that area in the Canterbury Land District bounded towards the south-west by the proposed Hororata County and the River Rakaia to the sea; towards the north-west by the proposed Hororata County and the Tawera County; towards the north-east and north by the Waimakariri River; towards the south-east and north-east by the Waimairi County to the City of Christchurch; thence by the City of Christchurch to Colombo Road South; towards the east by the middle of Colombo Road South and Dyer's Pass Road to the northern boundary of the Mount Herbert County; thence towards the east and south-east by the said Mount Herbert County and the Wairewa County to the sea at the outlet of Lake Ellesmere; thence towards the south-east by the sea to the mouth of the Rakaia River, the place of commencement.
