### A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to prohibit Film Exchanges from stipulating the Minimum Admission Fees to be charged by Theatre Proprietors. Title.

5 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Hire of Films Act, 1933. Short Title.
- 10 2. No covenant or condition shall bind the proprietor of any theatre to charge a minimum admission fee as a condition of the hire of film. Theatre proprietor not bound to charge minimum admission fee as a condition of hire of film.
3. This Act shall come into force on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and thirty-four. Commencement.
