HUTT PARK AMENDMENT.

[LOCAL BILL.]

A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Hutt Park Act, 1907.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Hutt Park Amendment Act, 1909, and it shall form part of and be read together with the Hutt Park Act, 1907.

Short Title.

Clause 2 struck out by the Lands Committee.

2. With respect to so much of the Hutt Park as is described in the Schedule hereto, the Hutt Park Committee is hereby declared to be a leasing authority within the meaning of the Public Bodies' Leases Act, 1908.

Leasing authority.

3. (1.) Section two of the Hutt Park Act, 1907, is hereby amended by repealing the words "principal Act" in subsection three, and substituting the words "Municipal Corporations Act, 1908."

Amendment.

Clause 4 (1) struck out by the Local Bills Committee, but reinstated by the Lands Committee.

4. (1.) Notwithstanding anything in section three of the Hutt Park Act, 1907, or in the Public Reserves and Domains Act, 1908, the number of days in any year on which the public may be excluded from free access to the Hutt Park, and on which authority may be granted to demand a charge for admission as provided in section twenty-nine of the last-mentioned Act, is hereby increased from ten days to twenty-six days.

Increase in number of days upon which charge for admission may be made.

Clause 4 (2) as amended by the Local Bills Committee.

Exemptions.

(2.) Nothing in the said section twenty-nine or this section of the Public Reserves and Domains Act, 1908, shall apply to the land described in the Schedule hereto.

Schedule.

SCHEDULE.*Struck out by the Local Bills Committee.*

ALL that parcel of land, comprising part of the Hutt Park Reserve, situate in the Hutt District, in the Provincial District of Wellington, being part of Section No. 12 on the plan of the Hutt District. Bounded towards the north by other part of the said section, 260·61 links; towards the south and east by other parts of the said Hutt Park Reserve, 260·6 links and 1800·66 links respectively; and towards the west by Randwick Road, 1800 links.

Inserted by the Local Bills Committee.

ALL that area in the Wellington Land District, containing by admeasurement 4 acres 1 rood 28·9 perches, more or less, being part of the Hutt Park Reserve, situated in Block XIV, Belmont Survey District. Bounded towards the north by part of Section No. 12, 260·6 links; towards the east and south by the other part of the said Hutt Park Reserve, 1700 and 260·6 links respectively; and towards the west by Randwick Road, 1700 links.
