A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Hauraki Plains Act, 1908.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Hauraki Plains Amendment Act, 1914, and shall form part of and be read together with the Hauraki Plains Act, 1908.

Short Title.

2. Section two of the Hauraki Plains Amendment Act, 1913, is hereby amended by omitting from subsection one the words "one hundred and forty-five thousand," and substituting the words "one hundred and seventy thousand."
