A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Hutt Park Act, 1907.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Hutt Park Amendment Act, 1916, and shall form part of and be read together with the Hutt Park Act, 1907.

Short Title.

2. The Land vested by the Hutt Park Act, 1907, in the joint committee appointed in pursuance of that Act shall be exempt from all rates made and levied by any local authority after the first day of April, nineteen hundred and sixteen.
