A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to provide for the Vesting and Control of certain Land at Lower Hutt. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand  
5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Hutt Park Act, 1907.

2. (1.) From and after the passing of this Act the land described  
10 in the Schedule hereto, and now vested in trustees under the Hutt  
Public Park and Racecourse Act, 1866 (which land is hereinafter  
referred to as the said land), is hereby vested in trust for recreation  
purposes in a joint standing committee appointed from time to time  
under the provisions of Part VII of the Municipal Corporations Act,  
1900, by the Councils of the Boroughs of Petone and Lower Hutt.

15 (2.) Such joint committee shall be a body corporate under the  
name of the Hutt Park Committee, and shall have and may exercise  
in relation to the said land all the powers and duties conferred by  
the said Act on Councils, except the power to borrow money or  
make a rate.

20 3. The joint committee may from time to time let, under the  
provisions of Part XXI of the Municipal Corporations Act, 1900,  
such portions of the said land as it considers are not immediately  
required for recreation purposes.

Power to let land.

25 4. The rents and profits derived under this Act from the said  
lands shall, after payment of all expenses of administration, be applied  
in improving the said land in such manner as the joint committee  
determines.

30 5. (1.) Within thirty days after receiving from the joint com-  
mittee a request so to do, the trustees in office under the Hutt Public  
Park and Racecourse Act, 1866, shall furnish under the hand of their  
chairman to the joint committee a balance-sheet showing the financial

position of the trust, and pay over to the joint committee or to such person as it appoints all moneys (if any) then remaining in the hands of the trustees after payment of all liabilities.

(2.) On compliance with the provisions of this section the trustees shall cease to hold office, and shall be freed from all liability in respect of their trust. 5

Repeal.

6. The Wellington Provincial Ordinance known by the Short Title of the Hutt Public Park and Racecourse Act, 1866, is hereby repealed.

Schedule.

#### SCHEDULE.

ALL that parcel of land, containing by admeasurement 89 acres, more or less, being part of Section 12 on plan of Hutt District. Bounded towards the north by other part of said section, 2450 links; towards the north-east by Section 13, 2008 links; towards the east and south-east by Section 15, 530 links, 800 links, 700 links, and 970 links; towards the south-west and south by a Native reserve 1200 links, 530 links, and 418 links; and towards the west by a public road and the Waiwetu River, 2540 links: excepting always the piece of land containing 4 acres, more or less, known as Frethey's Island, and granted to Thomas Frethey.
