A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to confer certain Powers on the Hauraki Plains County Council. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Hauraki Plains County Council Empowering Act, 1924. Short Title.

2. The Hauraki Plains County Council is hereby authorized to raise *by way of loan* the sum of one thousand seven hundred pounds and the sum of one thousand four hundred pounds over the County of Hauraki Plains for the purpose of paying off the balance of the Orchard Bridge Loan and its liability to the Ohinemuri County Council in respect of the Waihou (Puke) Bridge Loan respectively, under the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913; ~~by special order, without~~ *Struck out.* Power to raise loan by special order.

3. The Hauraki Plains County Council may, from time to time, for the purpose of constructing or contributing towards the construction of bridges over the Waihou and Piako Rivers, borrow moneys in the manner provided by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, and secured by special rates over the County of Hauraki Plains, without taking the steps described in sections eight to twelve of that Act.
