A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT relating to the Depositing and Disposal of Nightsoil within the Heathcote Road District. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Heathcote Road District Nightsoil Act, 1899." Short Title.

2. The Heathcote Road Board may from time to time appoint places as depots or receptacles for the depositing or disposal of nightsoil within the Heathcote Road District, but no such place or depot shall be appointed or remain so appointed unless situated at least half a mile from a public road or from any dwelling-house; and any such appointment may be from time to time revoked. Heathcote Road Board may appoint places for deposit of nightsoil.

3. Any person depositing or disposing of nightsoil on any land or premises within the Heathcote Road District, not being a place for the time being appointed under the *second* section hereof, shall be liable to a penalty of not exceeding *five pounds* for every such offence. Penalty.

4. Nothing in this Act shall be construed to prevent any person depositing or disposing on the land or premises occupied by him of nightsoil not conveyed thereto from outside the limits of such land or premises. Not to interfere with residents.

5. Nothing in this Act shall be deemed to prevent the deposit of nightsoil by any public body on the reserve at present used for that purpose and vested in the City of Christchurch. Not to interfere with Christchurch Reserve.
