A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to render Titles of Honour Non-hereditary in New Zealand. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Hereditary Titles Prevention Act, 1911. Short Title.

2. It is hereby declared that dignities and titles of honour granted or created after the passing of this Act shall not be deemed in New Zealand to be incorporeal hereditaments, and that the issue of any person resident in New Zealand on whom any dignity or title of honour shall hereafter be conferred shall in New Zealand have no other rank or privilege than he would have had if such dignity or title of honour had not been so conferred. Titles not to be hereditary.
