1. This Act may be cited as the Impounding Amendment Short Title. Act, 1908, and shall be read together with and deemed to form part of the Impounding Act, 1908 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Section seventeen of the Impounding Act, 1908, hereinafter called the principal Act, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following subsection:

Cattle to be delivered up on payment of expenses before impounding.

Whenever any cattle have been seized by any person for 15 the purpose of impounding them in accordance with this section seventeen of the principal Act, if the owner of the cattle or any person on his behalf, before the cattle have been actually impounded, pays or tenders to the person in whose possession they are the charges for leading or driving cattle to the nearest pound as provided in Part 20 II of the Second Schedule of to the principal Act, together with the amount of any expenses incurred as provided for in the said section seventeen of the principal Act, the person in whose possession the cattle are shall forthwith deliver them up to the owner or to the person so paying or tendering on his behalf; but no such delivery 25 shall exempt any person from any penalty to which he would have been liable if the cattle had been impounded in pursuance of this the said section seventeen.
