INVERCARGILL LICENSING TRUST AMENDMENT BILL

EXPLANATORY NOTE

By section 3 of the Invercargill Licensing Trust Act 1950, the boundaries of the Invercargill Licensing Trust district are fixed and defined in a Schedule, and coincide with the City of Invercargill and the Borough of South Invercargill as constituted at the passing of that Act. Elections of members of the Trust are conducted on the local body rolls.

This Bill provides that the boundaries of the Trust district may be altered by Order in Council, at the request of the Trust, for the purpose of ensuring that as far as possible the Trust district boundaries will coincide with the city and borough boundaries as altered from time to time. No alteration is to include within the Trust district any licensed premises, or any part of any special area in which a poll is required before licences may be granted, or any part of a no-licence district.

A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend the Invercargill Licensing Trust Title. Act 1950.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New 5 Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Invercargill Licens- Short Title. ing Trust Amendment Act 1954, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Invercargill 1950, No. 33 10 Licensing Trust Act 1950 (hereinafter referred to as the

principal Act).

2. (1) Section three of the principal Act is hereby Power to alter amended by inserting, after subsection one, the following boundaries of Trust district. subsections:

"(1A) The Governor-General may from time to time by Order in Council, on the recommendation of the Minister made at the request of the Trust, alter and redefine the boundaries of the Trust district in such manner as he thinks fit for the purpose of ensuring that,

20 so far as may be expedient, the boundaries of the Trust district shall be the same as the boundaries of the said city and borough as for the time being constituted:

"Provided that the boundaries of the Trust district shall not be so altered as to include—

"(a) Any licensed premises within the meaning of

the Licensing Act 1908:

"(b) Any part of any special area within the meaning of section fourteen of the Licensing Amendment Act (No. 2) 1953:

"(c) Any part of any no-licence district for the time being constituted under the Licensing Act

1908.

"(1B) Every Order in Council under subsection one A of this section shall be laid before Parliament within twenty-eight days after the date of the making thereof if Parliament is then in session, and, if not, shall be laid before Parliament within twenty-eight days after the 15 date of the commencement of the next ensuing session."

(2) The said section three is hereby further amended by omitting from subsection one the words "which shall comprise", and substituting the words "which, subject to the provisions of this section, shall comprise".
